EDUCATIONAL EVALUATION AND RESEARCH (M.ED.)

An admissions moratorium is currently in effect for this program.

Admission: Students are admitted every semester and must meet the general admission requirements for the Master of Education (https://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/college-education/academic-regulations/education-masters-degrees/).

A minimum of thirty credits is required for this degree under Plan A, B, or C. Required courses include ED 7999 if Plan B or C is elected, or ED 8999 for Plan A. In addition, a minimum of twelve credits in educational evaluation and research. All course work must be completed in accordance with the academic procedures of the College of Education (http://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/college-education/academic-regulations/) and the Graduate School's (http://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/general-information/degree-certificate-requirements/) regulations governing graduate scholarship and degrees.
